PROGRAM FOR 2012 RIFLE AND PISTOL MATCHES

SMALL BORE RIFLE PRONE - per NRA rules

100 yard – 1 match Any sight / 1 match Metallic sight / 40 shots per match

PISTOL MATCHES – per NRA rules

25 yards – 10 shots slow fire in 10 minutes/ 10 shots timed fire (2 x 5 shots/20 sec)/ 10 shots rapid fire (2 x 5 shots/10 sec)

Above course of fire to be shot once with .22 cal rimfire, once with center-fire, once with .45 cal handgun. Two hands may be used for center-fire and .45 cal handgun.

HIGH POWER RIFLE MATCHES – per NRA rules – service rifle or match rifle

100 yards – 50 shot National Match Course – 10 shots slow fire standing, 10 shots rapid fire sitting, 10 shots rapid fire prone, 20 shots slow fire prone.

M-1 CARBINE MATCHES – per CMP rules

100 yards – 5 sighters/5 minutes; 10 shots/5 min prone; 10 shots rapid fire prone/60 sec; 10 shots rapid fire sitting/50 sec; 10 shots slow fire standing/10 min.

M-1 GARAND / M1A MATCH – per CMP rules

100 yards – 5 sighters/5 min; 10 shots/10 min prone; 10 shots rapid fire prone/80 sec; 10 shots rapid fire sitting/70 sec; 10 shots slow fire standing/10 min.

SPRINGFIELD/ VINTAGE MILITARY BOLT ACTION MILITARY RIFLE MATCH

100 yards – 5 sighters/5 min; 10 shots/10 min prone; 10 shots rapid fire prone/ 80 sec; 10 shots rapid fire sitting/70 sec; 10 shots slow fire standing/10 min.

SERVICE RIFLE MATCH – MINI RATTLE BATTLE – TEAM MATCH

4 shooters + 1 coach/team, 192 rounds divided among the 4 shooters, 50 second time limit, 6 targets. Firing commences on command. Scoring will be similar to the 600 yard stage of the actual Infantry Team Match at Camp Perry during the National Matches, except every saved round subtracts 6 points from the team's score. The coach/observer will be allowed to redistribute ammunition, help clear malfunctions (there are no alibis in this match), direct the fire onto the targets, etc.

Fired at 100 yards, on copy of the U.S. Army "E" target (Ray-vin.com).

Match fees \$10 adults, \$5 for juniors.

Sign up starts at 08:15am for Saturday matches, 2:00pm for Sunday matches.
